NOMINATION CONDITIONS

The event will be run under EA/FEI rules	The OC reserves the right to change or amend the program at its discretion. All owners and competitors will be personally responsible for damages to any third parties caused by themselves, their employees, their agents or their animals. All competitors IN EVERY RING must be financial members of EA. To compete in graded classes (height classes above 1.05m), all horses must hold current EA registration and performance cards. Refer to EA General Regulations Art 100.
Safety	Any person mounted upon a horse, must be wearing a properly secured helmet and correct footwear , which must comply with USA, Australian or European helmet standards. Refer to EA General Regulations Art 122.
Registrations	Any person competing in a class, must have a registration in that class either via Global Entries Online – or as a change of rider via the Office.
GST	GST is included in all fees and charges including entries, stables and prizes.
Prize money	Prize money will not be given out in any case, unless prize money claim forms are initialed by the Office. Prize money claim forms will be given out at mounted presentations or available at the office where no mounted presentation is held. Prize money will be paid via eft – in the week immediately after the event. Prize money claim forms will be given to all winning riders.
EA age rules	EA age rules apply (taken from the National Jumping Rules Art 255 dated 1 January 2016) for Juniors and Young Riders.
Amateur riders	Amateur rider classes are classes for riders who: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Must not have competed in an Olympic Games or World Equestrian Games in either Jumping or Eventing.• In the past 10 years must not have competed in a World Cup for Jumping Riders qualifying round or in a 4* 3 day event.• Must not have competed in section 1 and 2 at a Royal Show in Sydney, Brisbane, Melbourne, Adelaide or Perth in the past two years.• Amateur riders may not compete in an Amateur class if they compete in a class where the first round is higher than 1.20m at that show.• Amateur riders may not compete in an Amateur class on a horse that will compete in any class where the first round is higher than 1.20m at that show.
Dress rules	Formal dress rules apply – however riders will be permitted to remove their jackets at the discretion of the OC or the judge of each ring.
Presentations	Presentations will be mounted, and riders are expected to wear their coats – Ring One.

NOMINATION CONDITIONS (CONTINUED)

Dogs welcome	Dogs are welcome – but need to be on a leash at all times. Dogs are NOT permitted in the competition or warm up arenas at any stage.
Scratchings	Refunds will be given (less a \$20 admin fee) before the close of entries. After the close of entries, a 50% refund upon written request to the OC on production of a veterinary or medical certificate will be given. No refunds will be given for horses that do not start in a class once the event has commenced – nor will stables be refunded after Wednesday 21 August.
Entry changes	Entry changes will be allowed, but each entry change will incur a \$10 fee – such changes will not be actioned until payment is received. Entry changes must be made by 3.00 pm each day. Live editing via Global Entries Online will not attract a fee.
Incorrect entries	Coaches and parents – please note when filling out entries for your students or children – if you do not correctly fill out the name of your student or child online – an admin fee of \$25 per student/child will be imposed – this applies to any incorrect entry.
Concurrent classes	Where there are concurrent classes (A & B sections) in the program of events, horse and rider combinations may compete in only one section of the class.
Starts/day	Horses may start in a maximum of two classes per day. Horses may start in one class in one ring and another in a different ring – but will not for example, be allowed to do two height classes and then an Amateur – or Junior event.
Maximum number of entries/class/rider	No rider will be permitted more than three entries per class. A riders' 2 nd and/or 3 rd horses in a class must be present near to the warm up arena. Classes will not be held up waiting for riders.
TSHA	Thoroughbred Sport Horse Association Classes: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Horses must obtain a competition licence to enter the classes. Licence available on the 'manage horses' page in Global Entries Online. Do this before entries open so you are ready to go and don't miss your classes. \$55 per calendar year per horse. Only horses with Thoroughbred Stud Book registration will be accepted. No part bred thoroughbreds.• Horses may start in only one TBSA section per day (they may have two starts per day – but only once in the TBSA section).
Draw order	Ring One with no exceptions at any stage, will follow draw order.
Sunday – All rings	A horse may have only one start on Sunday (unless numbers allow).
Age of horse	As per EA rules – DOB of horse applies – and must be entered on Global Entries Online.

STABLING & CAMPING

Stabling at SIEC will be offered for The Riders' Series August Show and will be done through Waratah Showjumping entries on Global Entries Online (Class 39 is a blank class for those wishing to stable for Riders' Series and **NOT** attending Waratah Showjumping).

Riders' Series only	Bump in Friday 21 August – bump out Sunday 23 August (disregard the dates on Global Entries Online – just check the box for the stabling/camping/tack box or cabin option that you need): <ul style="list-style-type: none">• \$145 for two nights includes six bales shavings.
Waratah Showjumping	Bump in any night - bump out Sunday 30 August: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• \$145 for two nights, includes six bales shavings.• \$175 for three nights, includes six bales shavings.• \$205 for four nights, includes six bales shavings.• \$230 for five nights, includes six bales shavings – any five nights.• \$275 for six nights, includes seven bales shavings – extra bale at your request (minimal clean out of boxes required if you go home between Riders' Series and Waratah – your stable will be locked by the Stable Manager – so you'll have the same stable).
The whole lot	Nine nights - bump in Friday 21 August – bump out Sunday 30 August: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• \$360 for nine nights, includes eight bales shavings.• Six bales shavings on arrival and extra bale on Monday 24 and Thursday 27 August.
Stable bond	\$95/stable – refundable on sign off by the stable manager.
Tack room	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• \$36 for any two nights.• \$54 for any three nights.• \$72 for four nights.• \$90 for five nights – RS & WS – complete clean out of tack box.• \$108 for six nights.• \$162 – Whole lot – Nine days – Tack box will be locked if you go home between Riders' & Waratah Showjumping.
Extra nights	Stable: \$30 for an extra night – no extra shavings, if departing on Monday 31 August. Tack room: \$18 for an extra night – if departing on Monday 31 August.
Extra shavings	\$14.50/bale.
Camping	\$25/night/truck – two people. <i>Please note: Camping is charged per vehicle or power cord in the South Truck Park – so if there are two trucks; a truck and caravan; a truck and float plugged in (per competitor) – this will be charged as two camping fees. This is a SIEC charge and the security guard and stable manager will check each night. The OC will not be paying for a second vehicle in the South Truck Park. Extra vehicles may be parked on the grass nearest the dressage arena.</i> There will be no camping in the Northern Truck Park.
