## NOMINATION CONDITIONS

<b>The event will be run under EA/FEI rules</b>	EA Jumping Rules 1 July 2022, FEI Jumping Rules 1 January 2022, EA (FEI) WC Rules 1 January 2022. Including the following: <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>a. FEI Code of Conduct for the Welfare of the Horse</li><li>b. EA Code of Conduct for Conflict of Interest</li><li>c. FEI Code of Conduct for Jumping Warm Up Arenas</li><li>d. EA Code of Conduct</li><li>e. Australian Helmet Standards</li><li>f. Age Rules including Junior and Young Rider</li><li>g. Amateur Rules</li></ul>
<b>Conditions of Entry</b>	All riders competing at the event will be deemed to have read and accepted the Conditions of Entry, as evidenced by ticking the Agree Box prior to completion of your entry on Global Entries Online
<b>After a Fall</b>	After any fall anywhere at SIEC, the rider must present to the Medical Services Provider to be cleared BEFORE re-mounting. A rider falling voluntarily ie jumping off, anywhere outside the competition arena does not have to report to the MSP. Art 224 2
<b>Program</b>	The OC reserves the right to change or amend the program at its discretion.
<b>Acceptance &amp; Entries</b>	The OC reserves the right to accept or refuse any entry.
<b>Personal Responsibility</b>	All owners and competitors will be personally responsible for damages to any third parties caused by themselves, their employees, their agents or their animals.
<b>Draw Order</b>	Ring One with no exceptions at any stage will follow draw order. Should a horse need to be moved down the draw for exceptional reasons eg the loss of a shoe, the marshal shall communicate with the Judge to allow this.
<b>EA Membership</b>	All riders must be current financial full (includes Junior Classes) or participant members of EA.
<b>JNSW Membership</b>	All NSW registered riders must be current full financial members of Jumping NSW.
<b>Young Horse Class</b>	For any Young Horse Class an EA Jumping License must be purchased and the age rule of DOB of the horse will apply.
<b>Number of Starts</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>a. A horse can only have two starts on any day</li><li>b. Where there are concurrent classes as in an (a) and (b) section, a horse can only start in one section.</li><li>c. A rider may start in both sections of a concurrent class – but on different horses.</li><li>d. Where there is a Junior section in any class – if the rider meets the EA Junior rule – the rider must ride in the Junior section of that class</li></ul>
<b>Registration</b>	Any person competing in a class must have a registration in that class either via Global Entries Online – or as a change of rider via the Office.
<b>Swabbing Horses</b>	The OC reserves the right to swab horses.

## NOMINATION CONDITIONS (CONTINUED)

<b>Refunds</b>	Refunds will be given in full before close of entries, less a \$25 administration fee, please contact the OC as refunds are not done automatically. After entries have closed, a 50% refund will be given on presentation of a veterinary or doctor's certificate.
<b>Entry Changes</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>Are allowed at no charge via Live Editing</li><li>Will incur a \$10 fee if made outside Live Editing hours and must be made at the office.</li></ol>
<b>Incorrect Entries</b>	If an entry is incorrect at Close of Entries, an admin fee of \$25/incorrect entry will be incurred. This includes incorrect horse/rider combinations.
<b>Presentation of Prizes</b>	Presentations in Ring 1 will always be mounted and riders are expected to wear their jackets. Presentations in other rings will be at the direction of the OC.
<b>Dress</b>	Formal dress rules apply. Riders will be permitted to remove their jackets at the direction of the OC.
<b>Maximum number of starts</b>	Per rider in a class – No rider will be permitted more than three (3) entries in a class.
<b>Dogs &amp; Prams</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>Dogs must be on a lead at all times</li><li>Dogs are not allowed:<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>In the warm up arena</li><li>Walking the course</li><li>In the Indoor at any stage – including passing through</li></ol></li><li>Prams are not allowed:<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>In the warm up arena</li><li>Walking the course</li></ol></li></ol>
<b>Protests</b>	Must be addressed to the Ground Jury in writing and accompanied by a \$50 fee and can be lodged no later than 30 minutes after the announcement of the results of the relevant class.
<b>Thoroughbred Sport Horse Association Classes</b>	Horses must obtain a TSHA competition license to enter these classes. License is available on Global Entries Online (Manage Horses). Only horses with Thoroughbred Stud Book registration will be accepted. No part bred Thoroughbreds.
<b>Young Horse Boot Rule</b>	For any class or section of a class with an age requirement or limitation, the YH Boot Rule will apply – includes Futurity Classes.
<b>GST</b>	Is included in all fees and charges - and prize money.
<b>Prize money</b>	Will be paid through Global Entries Online, please upload your banking details into your Global Profile.
<b>Covid 19 Regulations</b>	Waratah Showjumping will abide by all current Public Health Orders at the time of the Event.

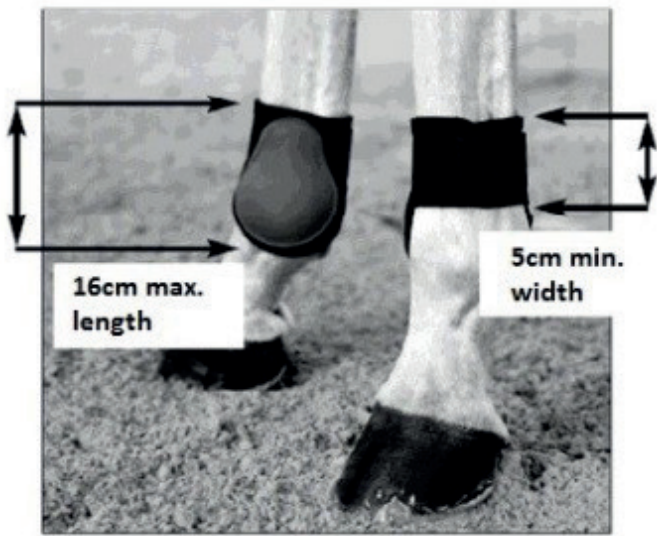

# HIND BOOT RULE

## YOUNG HORSE COMPETITIONS ART 257 2.3



2.3 EA: For ALL Jumping Competitions for young horses (four, five, six, seven and eight year old Horses) including horses eligible under Article 275: The following criteria must be respected in relation to hind boots worn at all Young Horses Competitions:

- Hind boots that have a rounded protective element on the inside only are the only type of hind boot allowed. The boot must have a maximum interior length of 16 centimetres; the width of the fastener must be at least five centimetres. Hind boots with additional protection for the pastern that extends below the rounded shell on the inside of the boot are allowed providing the protection is made of soft pliable material. The pastern protection that extends below the rounded shell on the inside is not taken into account when measuring the length of the boot. (refer to FEI Jumping Stewards' Manual on the FEI website for photographs).
- Boots must be designed in such a way that both sides can be bent to fit around the Horse's leg without effort. The rounded protective element of the boot must be placed around the inside of the fetlock.
- The inside of the boot must be non-abrasive and smooth, that is, the surface must be even and there may not be any pressure points, i.e. there may be no pads or blocks under the lining, on the inside of the boot; for the avoidance of doubt, stitching on the inside of the protective element that attaches the inner lining to the boot, is permitted. Sheepskin linings are allowed.
- Only non-elastic Velcro-type fasteners are permitted; no hooks, buckles, clips or other methods of attaching the fasteners may be used. The inside surface of the fastener that is in direct or indirect contact with the horse's skin must be nonabrasive. The fastener must be one-directional, that is, the strap must be attached directly from one side of the boot to the fastening component on the other side of the boot but must not wrap around the entire boot. The fastener may be secured with another Velcro-type strap extending vertically over the fastener where it is attached to the fastening component (for examples, refer to the FEI Jumping Stewards' Manual Annexes).
- No additional elements may be added to or inserted in the boot itself. The use of Vet Wrap or similar lightweight bandaging material under hind boots is permitted; when possible it should be applied in the presence of the Steward. A member of the Stewarding team has the right at any time to require the VetWrap/bandaging material to be removed and re-applied in his/her presence.
- Fetlock rings may be used for protective purposes providing they are properly adjusted and loose, and providing the total weight of equipment on the horse's leg does not exceed 500 grams under any circumstances, including when the equipment is wet (see JRs 257.2.3). Pastern bands may be used around the pastern providing they are not overtightened.

## ARTICLE 275 – EA FUTURITY, STARS OF THE FUTURE AND FUTURE STARS CLASSES

3. For Horses that are 6yrs, 7yrs or 8yrs from the date of birth at the time of competition, there is no point restriction. For the calendar years 2021-2022 horses that are 9yrs from the date of birth at the time of competition may compete.
