# NOMINATION CONDITIONS

Entries open **7.00pm Wednesday 19 July 2023** and close on **Monday 7 August at 10am**.

- 1 This event is run under **EA/FEI rules & regulations**. EA Jumping Rules 1 July 2023, FEI Jumping Rules 1 January 2023, EA (FEI) WC Rules 1 January 2023.  
Including the following:
  - a. FEI Code of Conduct for the Welfare of the Horse
  - b. EA Code of Conduct for Conflict of Interest
  - c. FEI Code of Conduct for Jumping Warm Up Arenas
  - d. EA Code of Conduct
  - e. Australian Helmet Standards
  - f. Age Rules including Junior and Young Rider
  - g. Amateur Rules

---

- 2 All riders competing at the event will be deemed to have read and **accepted the Conditions of Entry**, as evidenced by ticking the Agree Box prior to completion of your entry on Equipe.

---

- 3 **After any fall anywhere** at SIEC, the rider must present to the Medical Services Provider to be cleared BEFORE re-mounting. A rider falling voluntarily ie jumping off, anywhere outside the competition arena does not have to report to the MSP. Art 224 2.

---

- 4 **The OC reserves the right to change or amend the program at its discretion.**

---

- 5 **The OC reserves the right to accept or refuse any entry.**

---

- 6 All owners and competitors will be personally responsible for damages to any third parties caused by themselves, their employees, their agents or their animals.

---

- 7 **Draw Order** – Ring One with no exceptions at any stage will follow draw order. Should a horse need to be moved down the draw for exceptional reasons eg the loss of a shoe, the marshal shall communicate with the Judge to allow this.

---

- 8 **All riders must be current financial full (includes Junior Classes) or participant members of EA.**

---

- 9 **All NSW registered riders must be current full financial members of Jumping NSW.**

---

- 10 **For any Young Horse Class an EA Jumping License** must be purchased and the age rule of DOB of the horse will apply.

---

- 11 **Number of Starts:**
  - a. A horse can only have two starts on any day
  - b. Where there are concurrent classes (as in an (a) and (b) section, a horse can only start in one section).
  - c. **A rider** may start in both sections of a concurrent class – but on different horses.
  - d. Where there is a Junior section in any class – if the rider meets the EA Junior rule – the rider must ride in the Junior section of that class.

---

- 12 **Any person competing in a class, must have a registration in that class either via Equipe Online – or as a change of rider via the Office.**

# NOMINATION CONDITIONS CONTINUED

- 13     **The OC reserves the right to swab horses.**
- 
- 14     **Refunds:** Refunds will be given in full before close of entries, less a \$25 administration fee, please contact the OC as refunds are not done automatically. After entries have closed, a 50% refund will be given on presentation of a veterinary or doctor's certificate. **Once the event has commenced – no refunds will be given.**
- 
- 15     **Entry Changes**  
Will incur a \$10 fee and must be made at the office.
- 
- 16     **Incorrect Entries** – if an entry is incorrect at Close of Entries, an admin fee of \$25/incorrect entry will be incurred. This includes incorrect horse/rider combinations.
- 
- 17     **Presentation of Prizes** – Presentations in Ring 1 will always be mounted and riders are expected to wear their jackets. Presentations in other rings will be at the direction of the OC. Art 256, EA Jumping Rules, 1 July 2023.
- 
- 18     **Dress** – Formal dress rules apply. Riders will be permitted to remove their jackets at the direction of the OC.
- 
- 19     **Maximum number of starts per rider in a class** – No rider will be permitted more than three (3) entries in a class.
- 
- 20     **Dogs & Prams**  
a.     Dogs must be on a lead at all times  
b.     Dogs are not allowed:  
      i.     In the warm up arena  
      ii.    Walking the course  
      iii.   In the Indoor at any stage – including passing through  
c.     Prams are not allowed:  
      i.     In the warm up arena  
      ii.    Walking the course
- 
- 21     **Protests:** Must be addressed to the Ground Jury in writing and accompanied by a \$50 fee and can be lodged no later than 30 minutes after the announcement of the results of the relevant class.
- 
- 22     **Young Horse Boot Rule** – Young Horse Boot Rule – For any class with a Young Horse Section (eg Class 12c in Ring 2 at the WC Weekend) the non YH sections will follow the usual National Boot Rules. For the YH section, this will be run AFTER the first section(s) and the Young Horse Boot Rule will apply. Art 257 EA Jumping Rules, 1 July 2023 (see picture on last page of the Program).
- 
- 23     **GST** – is included in all fees and charges, and prize money.
- 
- 24     **Prize money** – will be paid through Equipe, please upload your banking details into your Equipe Profile.
- 
- 25     **Sunday Starts:**  
Horses may have only one (1) start on Sunday in Rings 1 & 2 – Ring 3 may be allowed at the discretion of the OC.

3. For Horses that are 6yrs, 7yrs or 8yrs from the date of birth at the time of competition, there is no point restriction. For the calendar years 2021-2022 horses that are 9yrs from the date of birth at the time of competition may compete.

## FOR WORLD CUP QUALIFIER RIDERS:

- If you have 2 horses in the WCQ, the horse nominated for WC points must be declared to the PGJ before the start of the competition – at the Horse Inspection (Trot Up)
- If you have 2 horses – the nominated horse must be ridden first in both rounds.
- Bridle numbers must be displayed at all times the horse is not in its stable
- WC horses must be stabled on Friday 18 August
- WC horses must have their stable marked with contacts – the OC will supply the form to be attached to your stable
- Horses must complete a competition of 1.30m or above at Waratah WC show. (There are several to choose from!)
- The Person Responsible must download the FEI Horse Health App and follow the instructions regarding temperature checking
- Vet Arrival check will be between 8am and 10am on Friday 18 August
- Horse Inspection will be at 10am on Friday 18 August
- Any representations required will be at 7am on Saturday 19 August
- All clear rounds or the top 12 placed will be invited back for the second round.

Fastener: must be non-elastic Velcro with a minimum height of 5 cm.

Hind boots that have a rounded protective element on the inside only.

Maximum height at longest point: 20 cm.

Velcro-type fastener may be elastic or non-elastic.

If 1 fastener: 5 cm.

If 2 fasteners: 2.5 cm each.

Only non-elastic Velcro-type fasteners are permitted; no hooks, buckles, clips or other methods of attaching the fasteners may be used.
