NOMINATION CONDITIONS

Nominations via www.globalentriesonline.com

Entries open 7.00pm Wednesday 23 July 2025 and close 10.00am Monday 11 August 2025.

- 1 This event is run under EA/FEI rules & regulations: EA Jumping Rules 1 January 2024, FEI Jumping Rules 1 January 2024, EA (FEI) WC Rules 1 January 2024. This includes:
 - a FEI Code of Conduct for the Welfare of the Horse
 - b EA Code of Conduct for Conflict of Interest
 - c FEI Code of Conduct for Jumping Warm Up Arenas
 - d EA Code of Conduct
 - e Australian Helmet Standards
 - f Age Rules including Junior and Young Rider
 - q Amateur Rules
- All riders competing at the event will be deemed to have read and accepted the **Conditions of Entry**, as evidenced by ticking the Agree box prior to completion of your entry on Global Entries Online.
- 3 After any fall anywhere at SIEC, the rider must present to the Medical Services Provider to be cleared BEFORE re-mounting. A rider falling voluntarily i.e. jumping off, anywhere outside the competition arena does not have to report to the MSP. See Art 224.2.
- 4 The OC reserves the right to:
 - a change or amend the program at its discretion
 - b accept or refuse any entry
 - c swab horses.
- All owners and competitors will be personally responsible for damages to any third parties caused by themselves, their employees, their agents, or their animals.
- 6 Draw Order Ring 1

Ring 1 with no exceptions at any stage will follow draw order as published on Equipe. Should a horse need to be moved down the draw for exceptional reasons e.g. the loss of a shoe, the marshal shall communicate with the Judge to allow this.

- 7 All riders must be current financial full (includes Junior Classes) or participant members of EA.
- 8 All NSW registered riders must be current full financial members of Jumping NSW.
- 9 Young Horse Classes

An EA Jumping License must be purchased and the age rule of DOB on the first day of competition at the event, of the horse will apply.

- 10 Number of Starts & Concurrent Classes:
 - a A horse can only have two starts on any day except:
 - i A horse can only have one start in ring 1 on Friday, Saturday, or Sunday.
 - ii A horse can only have one start in ring 2 on Sunday.
 - iii The OC may restrict horses to only one start in ring 3 on Sunday.
 - A concurrent class is one with multiple sections (a), (b), and so on.
 - i A horse can only start in one of the sections.
 - ii A rider may start in both sections, but on different horses.
 - iii If a class has a Junior section and a rider meets the EA Junior rule, the rider must ride in the Junior section of that class.
 - c If two classes are walked at the same time, a horse can only start in one of these classes.
 - d No rider will be permitted more than three entries in a class.
- Any person competing in a class, must have a registration in that class either via Global Entries Online or as a change of rider via the Office.

NOMINATION CONDITIONS (continued)

12 Refunds

Refunds will be given in full before close of entries, less a \$60 administration fee. Please contact the OC as refunds are not done automatically.

- a After entries have closed, a 50% refund will be given on presentation of a veterinary or doctor's certificate.
- b Once the Show has started, no refunds will be given.

13 Entry Changes

- a Entry changes are allowed between 8.00am and 3.00pm each day of the Show via Live Editing at no charge.
- b Entry changes outside these times must be made at the office and will incur a \$10 fee.

14 Incorrect Entries

If an entry is incorrect at Close of Entries, an admin fee of \$25/incorrect entry will be incurred. This includes incorrect horse/rider combinations.

15 Presentation of Prizes

Presentations in Ring 1 will always be mounted and riders are expected to wear their jackets. The winner and place getters must be present or have a representative in the Presentation. Presentations in other rings will be at the direction of the OC. See Art 256, EA Jumping Rules, 1 January 2024.

16 Dress

Formal dress rules apply in all arenas. Riders will be permitted to remove their jackets at the direction of the OC.

17 Dogs

- a Dogs must be on a lead at all times.
- b Dogs are not allowed in the indoor arena at any time, including "passing through".
- c Dogs are not allowed in the warm up arena.
- d Dogs are not allowed walking the course.
- 18 **Prams** are not allowed in the warm up arena or walking the course.

19 Minor Children

Children under the age of 18 years old must be accompanied by a parent or adult at all times. They cannot be left overnight without supervision by a parent or nominated adult.

20 **Protests** must be addressed to the Ground Jury in writing and accompanied by a \$200 fee and can be lodged no later than 30 minutes after the announcement of the results of the relevant class.

21 Young Horse Boot Rule

The Young Horse Boot Rule will apply in any class or section of a class with an age requirement or limitation, including Futurity Classes.

- 22 **GST** is included in all fees and charges, and prize money.
- 23 **Prize money** will be paid through Global Entries Online. Please upload your banking details into your Global Profile.
- 24 Draws and Start Times will be published on Equipe.

Futurity Classes

As per EA Article 275, these are for horses 6, 7, or 8 years from their date of birth, at the time of the competition. There is no point restriction.

FEI World Cup Qualifier

Please check the current Australian WC Rules on the EA website so you are familiar with what you need to do.

www.equestrian.org.au/sites/default/files/AUS_WC_Rules_Clean_Effective_Jan2022_FEI%20_update.pdf

Here are some of the main points:

- If you have 2 horses in the World Cup Qualifier, the horse nominated for World Cup points must be declared to the President of the Ground Jury before the start of the competition, at the Horse Inspection (Trot Up).
- If you have 2 horses, the nominated horse must be ridden first in both rounds.
- Bridle numbers must be displayed at all times the horse is not in its stable.
- WC horses must be stabled on Friday 22 August.
- WC horses must have their stable marked with contacts. The OC will supply the form to be attached to your stable.
- Horses must complete a competition of 1.30m or above at Waratah World Cup show prior to the World Cup Qualifier.
- The Person Responsible must download the FEI Horse Health App and follow the instructions regarding temperature checking.
- Vet Arrival check will be between 8am and 10am on Saturday 23 August.
- Horse Inspection will be at 11am on Saturday 23 August.
- Any representations required will be at 2pm on Saturday 23 August.
- All clear rounds or the top 12 placed will be invited back for the second round.

Camping

Camping is charged per vehicle or power cord in the South Truck Park.

So, if there are 2 trucks or a truck & caravan or a truck and float plugged in, this will be charged as 2 camping fees.

This is a SIEC charge and the Security Guard and Stable Manager will check each night.

The OC will not be paying for a second vehicle in the South Truck Park!

Horses are not allowed at STP overnight.

Cabins \$50 / night - no linen included

Portable stables \$600 fixed price for both weekends.

Once booked this cannot be refunded unless the stable can be "sold" to another.

A minimum of 60 stables have to be booked. If the load is cancelled, a full refund will be issued.

BEHAVIOUR
